Mob Link is an initiative of the Institute for Urban Indigenous Health to support Aboriginal and Torres Strait Islander people living in South East Queensland to connect to health and social support services.

Open 365 days a year, from 7am to 7pm, Mob Link can provide access to same day care and/or a connection to a variety of health and social services.

Staffed with intake officers, nurses and general practitioners, Mob Link provides care via a virtual care model with continuity of care pathways linking care to primary care providers.

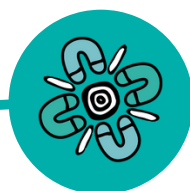
With links to primary, secondary and tertiary care pathways, Mob Link supports our Community Members to navigate the health care system and ensure continuity of care.
