# OUR SERVICES

We provide culturally safe space for Aboriginal and Torres Strait Islander women or those having an Aboriginal and Torres Strait Islander baby.

At Jajumbora BiOC we offer:

- support from pregnancy through to parenthood and until the child is three years old
- a dedicated family support worker to provide wraparound support
- a primary midwife for your antenatal, birthing and postnatal care
- holistic care working alongside a senior family support specialist
- baby and children's health checks and immunisations
- connections and referrals to other services.

At Jajumbora Birthing in our Community (BiOC) we're here to help and support you with your journey of pregnancy and wellbeing at every stage. Our experienced team will work alongside you and your family to ensure you receive respectful, trusting and continuity of care.

## OUR TEAM

We have a team of family support workers and midwives, as well as a child health nurse, senior family support specialist and transport driver. Our team have a strong background in community health and wellbeing and are passionate about providing one-on-one support for women and their families.

Appointments are available at Jajumbora BiOC or we can visit you at home. We offer flexibility with appointments and can provide transport if needed\*.
